#### **Job Purpose**

To effectively plan and execute tasks set by the Senior Carpenter, including the supervision and training of apprentices and other co-workers; in order to achieve set targets, optimise output and ensure safe working practices.

Day to day on the job supervision of Handymen and apprentices.

Use and care of Plant & Machinery £25,000.

Direct supervision and training of apprentices in craft skills and health and safety matters.

#### Main Accountabilities:

- To plan and execute skilled and semi-skilled tasks as generally directed by the immediate supervisor in an efficient, effective and safe manner.
- Occasionally act as team leader on construction projects ensuring that all works are fully completed on time and to a high standard.
- Impart knowledge and skills to apprentices in order that they develop their full potential, including routine testing of their learned skills to monitor progress.
- Carry out routine inspections and checks on workshop machinery, tools, and equipment to ensure these are safe for their intended purpose.
- Carrying out routine maintenance to hand powered tools and equipment to ensure optimum operation.
- Direct and monitor other persons provided to assist in carrying out tasks to ensure safe and effective working.
- Take adequate care of resources being used to ensure no damage is caused to assets.

The job description is not an exclusive or exhaustive definition of your duties. You shall undertake such additional or other duties as may reasonably be required by FIG commensurate with your role and grade.



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#### **Additional Information:**

The post requires the ability of the holder to be able to work within a small team "Good Team Player". The position often involves daily contact with FIG tenants, FIG Departments and members of the public therefore politeness and tact are essential at all times.

Much of the work will be undertaken with general rather than close supervision.

Imparting trade skills to trainees and apprentices is an important part of the job function.
