


HPAI: Bird Flu Know the Facts










If it arrives, it could have major impacts on our wildife and domestic poultry.

What to look out for?

Look out for dead or sick birds, symptoms include:

- Sudden and rapid increase in birds found dead
- Loss of coordination and balance
- Trembling head and body
- Lethargy
- Respiratory distress
- Twisting of head and neck
- Swollen head







If you see dead or sick birds:

- **DON'T TOUCH** them
- Keep your distance
- Note the location and nature of your observations, take photos if possible
- Leave the area, ensuring that your boots and clothing are cleaned and disinfected as soon as you can
- **REPORT** to the FIG Veterinary Service
