#### Guidance for Taxi Drivers – 14 May 2020

The Falkland Islands Government on 1 May, 2020, announced it was appropriate to ease some restrictions put in place in late March in response to the global COVID-19 pandemic.

These changes, which were effective 11 May, include allowing greater social interaction, and letting the majority of businesses who had previously been asked to cease non-essential work to now resume activity.

The below guidance is specific for taxi drivers.

#### Guidance:

- Passengers to be carried in the back seat
- Only one passenger per trip unless they live in the same household
- Windows to be open to ensure good ventilation
- Good hand hygiene, use of hand cleaning gel
- Regular cleaning of high touch areas such as door handles
- Maintain a diary of your trips – and start a new one every 14 days. This would help contact tracing
