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
Thinking about your life in general before the COVID-19 outbreak, would you say your life is now better, worse or unchanged?

Thinking about the height of the COVID-19 outbreak, how would you rate your level of stress at that time?





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
Thinking about the COVID-19 outbreak, to what extent would you say you were stressed about the following:

Restrictions or shortages of food and other supplies




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Social distancing restrictions

Transport and movement restrictions within the Islands






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Restrictions on transport for leaving the Islands



Thinking about the Public Health messaging, information and guidance issued by FIG in response to the COVID-19 outbreak; please indicate which source of information you prefer to access most.





