Infectious Diseases Control (Coronavirus) Regulations 2020 (S. R. & O. No 6 of 2020)

In accordance with regulation 2, these Regulations came into force on 24 March 2020 on their publication in the Gazette.

- 1. In accordance with regulation 4, the Governor gives notice that, having consulted with the Chief Medical Officer, he has declared that
 - (a) the incidence or transmission of coronavirus constitutes a serious and imminent threat to public health in the Falkland Islands; and
 - (b) the powers conferred by these Regulations will be an effective means of preventing significant further transmission of coronavirus in the Falkland Islands.
- 2. In accordance with regulation 3(1), the Governor gives notice that he has declared that the following are "infected areas" —

Any country, territory, or area which has been classified by the World Health Organisation to be a country, territory or area which has "Local transmission" of cases of coronavirus
