

Infectious Diseases Control (Coronavirus) Regulations 2020 (S. R. & O. No 6 of 2020)

In accordance with regulation 2, these Regulations came into force on 24 March 2020 on their publication in the Gazette.

1. In accordance with regulation 4, the Governor gives notice that, having consulted with the Chief Medical Officer, he has declared that —
 - (a) the incidence or transmission of coronavirus constitutes a serious and imminent threat to public health in the Falkland Islands; and
 - (b) the powers conferred by these Regulations will be an effective means of preventing significant further transmission of coronavirus in the Falkland Islands.

2. In accordance with regulation 3(1), the Governor gives notice that he has declared that the following are “infected areas” —

Any country, territory, or area which has been classified by the World Health Organisation to be a country, territory or area which has “Local transmission” of cases of coronavirus
