

INVITATION TO TENDER

Consultancy on reviewing Falkland Island Finfish Fisheries For the Falkland Islands Government

The Falkland Islands Government (FIG) Natural Resources Directorate is responsible for the management of fisheries within Falkland Islands waters and is seeking tenders from suitably qualified individuals, institutes or research groups to undertake a comprehensive review of the assessment and management of finfish fisheries.

The fisheries sector has been the mainstay of the Falkland Islands economy since the declaration of the initial Fishery Conservation Zone in 1986 and the associated licensing and management regime.

The Falkland Islands fishery has a number of components including a fishery involving a number of finfish species fished across a range of fishing licences. Current finfish fisheries are incorporated into the Individual Transferable Quota (ITQ) system.

FIG wishes to commission a review of its management of Falkland Island finfish fisheries and resources. The review is to be comprehensive including management objectives and processes, identification of knowledge gaps, potential future science and research priorities to support these fisheries and to consider options for alternative management strategies.
