## Job Purpose

Provide domestic and dish washing support to the Health Services Kitchen Department and ensure hospital standards of hygiene are maintained.

## Main Accountabilities:

- Wash, dry and put away all dishes as used by the kitchen, ward and other internal Departments.
- Wash all trays used for Meals on Wheels and Police Station.
- Assist the duty cook with the plating of meals and in emergencies help with the preparation of sandwiches and salads.
- Undertake cleaning of kitchen equipment i.e. microwave, trolleys.
- Ensure that all kitchen, larder and office floors are washed.
- Ensure that all kitchen waste bins are emptied and washed.
- Report to the appropriate person any defects or damage in equipment used, or rooms that need to be cleaned so that immediate action can be taken to rectify the problem.
- Ensure the prescribed standards of hospital hygiene are met and maintained.
- Keep confidential anything that is seen or heard concerning patients and staff to honour and maintain the KEMH policy of confidentiality.

***The job description is not an exclusive or exhaustive definition of your duties. You shall undertake such additional or other duties as may reasonably be required by FIG commensurate with your role and grade.***

## Additional Information:

The successful candidate must be clean and tidy and have a polite manner. Successful candidates must also be prepared to work on a rota system, which will include unsocial hours.
