### Fisheries (Conservation and Management) Ordinance 2005

section 17A

#### Notice of intention to grant fishing rights

In accordance with section 17A of the Fisheries (Conservation and Management) Ordinance 2005 ("the Ordinance") notice is given that the Director intends to grant Individual Transferable Quota B ("ITQB") in relation to fishing in these fisheries:-

Finfish All finfish species except Skate (Rajidae)

and Toothfish (Dissostichus eleginoides)

Scallops Zygochlamys patagonica

(a) Only companies that appear on both Part B of the Individual Transferable Quota Eligibility Register and Part A of the Individual Transferable Quota Ownership Register for the relevant fishery will be considered.

- (b) ITQB will be granted to companies meeting the criteria in (a) and that have submitted a valid application form to the Director before the end of the application period. Application forms and associated guidance can be found at ITQ B (falklands.gov.fk).
- (c) ITQB will be granted in an amount equal to the Individual Transferable Quota A surrendered by the applicant company, as specified in the application form.
- (d) ITQB will be granted for a period of 25 years from 1 January 2023 unless it is sooner cancelled or otherwise ceases to apply or to have effect.
- (e) The Director will cause particulars of provisional grants of ITQB to be published in the Gazette following the end of the application period.
- (f) Any person aggrieved by the decision to grant or not to grant ITQB can apply to the Disputes Commission (under section 108 of the Ordinance) to review the matter. The grant will become final if no applications for review are made within 14 days. If an application is made to the Disputes Commission, the grant will not become final until the application has been dealt with or disposed of, and will not be made at all if the Disputes Commission (and any appeal from the Disputes Commission to the Supreme Court) does not confirm the Director's decision to grant ITQB.
- (g) The application period will be open until 31 May 2022. Dated 15 February 2022
