**Retail Prices Index**

The Retail Prices Index for the quarter ended 31 December 2022 has now been completed.

The Index has increased by 7.0% to 121.725. The change in the Index over the year to 31 December 2022 has been +11.8%.

The data points to a substantial increase in price growth compared to previous quarters; much of the quarterly and year-over-year growth is attributed to sustained and substantial price growth in fuel (including vehicle fuel and power). Quarterly growth in the 'food and non-alcoholic beverages' category continues, however at a lower magnitude than recorded over previous quarters.

Evidence of inflation in the 'food and non-alcoholic beverages' category is again observed for quarter 4 of 2022, contributing +0.4% to quarterly inflation and +2.4% to annual inflation; and continuing the trend witnessed over the last three quarters. However, the quarterly change in this category is the smallest observed since quarter 4 of 2021.

'Communication' contributes -0.1% to quarterly inflation and -0.2% to annual inflation. This reflects the broadband unit price decrease in terms of cost per gigabyte following the 50% increase in broadband packages introduced by Sure South Atlantic Limited on 1 December 2022.

The majority of price growth is recorded in 'fuel and power', which contributes +5.8% to quarterly inflation and +6.8% to annual inflation (note that vehicle fuel is recorded under 'transport', rather than 'fuel and power'). Electricity price growth contributed +2.3% and +1.4% to annual and quarterly inflation respectively. The increase in kerosene price contributed +4.4% to quarterly inflation and +4.2% to annual inflation; the largest positive contributor across the Index.

While the kerosene price remained largely constant over 2022, following a rebound to levels largely consistent with 'pre-pandemic' prices, it has now increased by 55% compared to the same quarter of 2019. Diesel prices continue to rise; although less sharply than observed in the previous two quarters.
