Currency (Circulation Coins) Regulations Order 2023

I make these regulations by order under section 22 of the Currency Ordinance 1987 on the advice of Executive Council.

1. Title

This Order is the Currency (Circulation Coins) Regulations Order 2023.

2. Commencement

This Order comes into force on publication in the *Gazette*.

3. Prescribed denomination, weight, form, design and metal composition of 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p, 50p and £1 coins

(1) Under section 6(5)(a) of the Currency Ordinance 1987, the Commissioners may arrange the minting of coins of such denominations, such weight, form and design and made of such metal or metals as may be prescribed.

(2) Schedules 1 to 7 prescribe the denomination, weight, form, design and metal composition and the design of the obverse and reverse of 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p, 50p and £1 coins respectively.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
(not forming part of these regulations)

The Currency Ordinance 1987 gives the Commissioners of Currency (appointed under section 5(1) of the Ordinance) power to arrange for the issue and minting of coins in the denominations, weight, form, design and metal composition as are prescribed (section 6(5)). The Commissioners propose the issue and minting of new circulation coins and this Regulations Order prescribes the weight, form, design and metal composition in the denominations of 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p, 50p and £1 as required.

AN ORDINANCE

To authorise the appropriation from the Consolidated Fund of the additional amount of £2,318,446 for the financial year ending 30 June 2024.

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Falkland Islands —

1. Title

This Ordinance is the Supplementary Appropriation (2023-2024) Ordinance 2023.

2. Commencement

This Ordinance comes into force on publication in the *Gazette*.

3. Appropriation

(1) The additional amount of £2,318,446 is appropriated from the Consolidated Fund for the financial year ending 30 June 2024.

(2) The issue of the additional amount from the Consolidated Fund in the amounts necessary to replace an amount in accordance with section 4 and to supply the votes set out in the Schedule is authorised.

4. Replacement of amount withdrawn by authority of Contingencies Warrant

If an amount has been withdrawn from the Contingencies Fund by the authority of a Contingencies Warrant, the amount withdrawn must be replaced from the amount appropriated under section 3.
