AN ORDINANCE

To make provision for increasing various charges and fees, increase the prescribed rate of retirement pension payments and contributions, increase child care subsidy and the minimum wage, change the threshold amount of chargeable income and personal tax allowance, validate several fees and for connected matters.

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Falkland Islands —

1. Title

This Ordinance is the Finance Ordinance 2024.

2. Commencement

(1) Save as provided in subsections (2) and (3), the provisions of this Ordinance come into force on 1 July 2024.

(2) The amendments in the Schedule to the following come into force on 1 January 2025 —

- (a) the Minimum Wage Ordinance 2013;
- (b) the Taxes Ordinance 1997;
- (c) the Banking Regulations Order 1989;
- (d) the Embarkation Tax Regulations 1999; and

(e) regulations 3 and 5 of the Retirement Pensions (Prescribed Rates) Regulations 1996;

(3) The amendments in the Schedule to the Cruise Ships Ordinance 1998 come into force on 1 July 2025.

3. Amendment of primary and secondary legislation

(1) The Ordinances listed in the first column of Part A of the Schedule are amended to the extent specified in the second column.

(2) The secondary legislation listed in the first column of Part B of the Schedule are amended to the extent specified in the second column.

4. Validation of fees

(1) Any fees collected before the commencement of this Ordinance in excess of the amount prescribed under the Planning (General) Regulations 1991 are validated as if the amount had been provided for under those regulations.

(2) Any fees collected for a building permit under the Planning (General) Regulations 1991 are validated as if the amount had been provided for under the Building Regulations 1999.
