### Aids to Navigation Maintenance

Please note that from 5<sup>th</sup> November 2023 until 31<sup>st</sup> January 2024, a program to upgrade Aids to Navigation (AtoN) around East Falklands will commence. Mariners are kindly requested to exercise caution when navigating around the coast using these AtoN's. The Maritime Authority will minimise disruption to AtoN operation where possible.
