Appointments

- > Pre-Covid, visits to the Jane Cameron National Archives were by appointment only and this will not change.
- If you have an appointment but feel unwell please do not turn up but contact the archives to postpone your appointment or make alternate arrangements.
- > Please ring the doorbell beside the main entrance door before entering the building.

Hygiene

- There is hand sanitiser inside the building and all visitors are to sanitise their hands immediately on entry to the building. There is also hand sanitiser in the Reading Room and hand washing facilities available.
- > If you wish to use a face mask in the building and have forgotten to bring one with you there are reusable face masks available.

Closure of Archives

If the National Archivist has to isolate after contracting Covid 19 the Archives will be closed. If well enough she will work remotely otherwise there will be a slight delay in answering queries.
